

LTTA IN IRELAND

The Rural Hub hosted a successful 3-day training event in Ireland for a team of adult and community educators.

The training focused on equipping adult educators with the skills necessary to implement the HANGOUT Curriculum for NEETs (PR2) in their training programs for hard-to-reach young adults. The utilized audio-visual curriculum production as а learning environment to develop key marginalized competencies in young adults.

Partners selected two adult educators committed to using this approach and supporting the cascading model of training.



NATIONAL TRAININGS

The completion of in-service Continuous Professional Development training by the additional eight adult educators in each involved country will expand the reach of the HANGOUT project and equip them with the necessary skills to support young adults.

This will enhance the quality of training programs offered to NEETs, improving their chances of securing employment and achieving their goals.

The training program will enable educators to use audio-visual production learning as а environment. fostering key competencies of young adults and empowering them to become active participants in society.

WHAT'S NEXT?

In April 2023, all partners started to work on translating the finalized educational materials to the national languages.

In autumn, short film festivals will be held in all partner countries that will showcase the videos prepared by young adult target group members.

Finally, a conference hosted by ALK will be held in the Czech Republic during which all educational and technical results of the HANG OUT project will be presented.

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
